Re: Town Administrator's Report

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1. Legacy Place Openings-Over the past few weeks our inspectional services staff members have been working diligently to get final inspections in place to get new stores and restaurants open at Legacy Place. So far the openings have generally gone well with some typical bugs to be worked out. There has been a power problem at this location over the past few days that has been diagnosed by NSTAR and they are working closely with the development to resolve it. All expectations are that this issue will be resolved this week.
2. High and Harris Street Bridge- improvements are progressing well and appear to be in the home stretch. Paving for this project has been scheduled for the week of September 21. Brick pavers are now being installed below the new bridge and the final plans have been in the works for locating the new antique clock in this area. The Bridge and roadway improvements have been highly anticipated for nearly twenty years and we are now in the home stretch.
3. Canton and Everett Street Alterations and Improvements- A hearing has been requested by the Town of Westwood before the Norfolk County Commission on Wednesday, September 30, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. at the Norfolk Superior Courthouse, Main Courtroom, Second Floor, 650 High Street, Dedham, MA to seek input and comments on proposed changes to Canton and Everett Street in Westwood. The County Commission will first view the plan proposed by the Town of Westwood at their regular Commission Meeting starting at 10:00 A.M. The Town of Dedham has been notified as an abutting community and we have the plans available for the Board to view. The proposed changes to Canton Street indicate that the road will remain open to two way traffic.

4. SMA Field Construction is underway. Green Acres Landscaping Construction from Lakeville, MA is performing the work to construct the Town's first artificial turf field on the grounds of the Dolan Center (formerly the SMA Father's property). A significant amount of land clearing and site preparation is underway. I will continue to provide periodic updates as the project proceeds further.
