**Please note there were several items removed from the original section 00300 FORM OF GENERAL BID. Attached for use is the revised section 00300 FORM OF GENERAL BID.**

Below are answers to questions/comments submitted by plan holders.

*Q: Confirm that the lowering and plating of structures in reclaimed areas is incidental to item 403 and the raising to finish grade will be compensated under the respective items 220-220.8.*

A: The lowering and plating of structures in reclaimed areas is to be considered incidental to item 403. Raising to finish grade will be compensated under respective items 220 through 220.8.

*Q: Specifications for Items 403 and 701-703 say that compacting and grading is inclusive under these items. What is the intention of Item 170?*

A: Compacting and grading is to be considered incidental to items 403 and 701 through 703. Item 170 has been removed from the revised bid form.

*Q: Pavement notes provided for HMA driveways and sidewalks. Please provide pavement notes for mill/overlay and full depth reconstruction.*

A: The roads under this contract are to be rehabilitated by either reclamation or mill & overlay. Please refer to standard detail RS.01 in attachment D for asphalt top and binder course thickness based upon the roadway classification. Mill & Overlay roads are to remove and replace the top course of asphalt and reclaimed roads are to remove and replace both top and binder courses. Please note that all the roadways identified in Attachment E for year 1 of this contract are all classified as local roadways.

*Q: Items 751 and 765 listed twice.*

A: This has been corrected in the revised bid form.

*Q: No specifications provided for the following items which typically do not have a MADOT standard specification. Confirm these are applicable to this project.*

The selected Contractor shall furnish a performance bond and a payment bond in an amount at least equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract prices in accordance with Section 00610 PERFORMANCE BOND, Section 00620 PAYMENT BOND, and as stipulated in Section 00700 GENERAL CONDITIONS of these specifications.
